The violation(s) described in this Citation and Notification of Penalty is (are) alleged to have occurred on or about the day(s) the inspection was made unless otherwise indicated within the description given below.

Described herein are alleged violations of Virginia's Occupational Safety and Health Laws, standards and/or regulations. Any penalty proposed is based on the corresponding violation. In accordance with Virginia Code §40.1-49(B), you must abate all alleged violations by the dates listed and pay the penalties proposed, unless, within 15 working days (excluding weekends and Federal and State holidays) from the date you receive this citation, you submit a notice of contest to the Virginia Department of Labor and Industry Regional Office at the address listed above. Issuance of this citation does not constitute a finding by the Commissioner that you have violated the law, standard or regulation described unless you fail to file a notice of contest or this citation is affirmed by a court of law.

Please read the enclosed booklet entitled *Employers Rights* in conjunction with this citation to learn your rights and responsibilities.

Posting - Virginia law requires you to immediately post a copy of this Citation in a prominent place at or near the location of the violation(s), or, if it is not practicable because of the nature of your operations to do so, in a place where it will be readily observable by all affected employees. This Citation must remain posted until the violation(s) have been abated, or for 3 working days (excluding weekends, State and Federal holidays), whichever is longer. The penalty amounts may be marked out or covered up prior to posting. It should be noted that these amounts, however, are releasable by the Department in response to a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request.

Informal Conference - You have the right to an informal conference with the VOSH Regional Director at which you may present evidence which you believe supports amending either the citation or penalties proposed. An informal conference, which is held during the 15 working day contest period, is optional. If you wish to attend an informal conference, you must contact the VOSH Regional Director at the Regional Office listed above.

If you request an informal conference, you must notify your employees of the time and place. Be sure to bring to the conference any documentation of existing conditions as well as abatement steps taken thus far. If conditions warrant, this matter may be resolved amicably without the need for litigation, by way of an Informal Settlement Agreement.

Requesting an informal conference does not extend the 15 working day contest period.

Right to Contest - You have the right to contest this Citation. You may contest all citation items or only individual items. You may also contest proposed penalties and/or abatement dates without contesting the underlying violations. **This citation and the penalties proposed will become a final order of the Commissioner of Labor and Industry unless you notify the VOSH Regional Director in writing within 15 working days of receiving this citation that you contest the citation or any part thereof.**

Penalty Payment - Penalties are due within 15 working days of receipt of this notification unless you contest. Make your check or money order payable to "Commonwealth of Virginia". Please indicate the Inspection Number on the check or money order.

The Virginia Department of Labor and Industry does not agree to any restrictions or conditions or endorsements put on any check or money order for less than the full amount due, and will cash the check or money order as if these restrictions, conditions, or endorsements do not exist.

Notification of Corrective Action - For violations which you do not contest, you should notify the VOSH Regional Director at the Regional Office promptly, by completing the enclosed List of Corrective Actions/Abatement Verification form, that you have taken appropriate corrective action by the date(s) specified in this citation. The form must include abatement steps you have taken and the dates, together with adequate supporting documentation, e.g., drawings or photographs of corrected conditions, purchase/work orders related to abatement actions, air sampling results, etc.

Employer Discrimination Unlawful - The law prohibits discrimination against an employee who has filed a complaint or who has exercised any rights under the Labor Laws of Virginia. An employee who believes that he/she has been discriminated against may file a complaint no later than 60 days after the discrimination occurred with the Virginia Department of Labor and Industry, Occupational Safety and Health Discrimination Office at Powers-Taylor Building, 13 South Thirteenth Street, Richmond, Virginia 23219.

Notice to Employees - The law gives an employee or his/her representative the opportunity to contest any abatement date set for a violation if he/she believes the date to be unreasonable. The contest must be mailed to the Regional Office at the address shown above and postmarked within 15 working days (excluding weekends and Federal holidays) of the employers receipt of this Citation.

Citation 1 Item 1 Type of Violation: **Serious**

16 VAC 25-60-120: Located at 28 Wagner Road, Poquoson, Virginia, employees were utilizing the Brush Bandit Model 1890 wood chipper. A 14 year old employee was caught in the wood chipper where he received fatal injuries. The employer did not comply with manufacturer's operating manual, page-32, under daily startup check list which states "Each day before starting your machine these checks must be made."

Proposed Penalty: \$7,000.00

Citation 1 Item 2 Type of Violation: **Serious**

16 VAC 25-60-120: Located at 28 Wagner Road, Poquoson, Virginia, employees were utilizing a metal scoop/pan shovel to load leaves and clippings into the infeed chute of the wood chipper. The employer did not comply with the manufacturers operating manual, page-9 which states "A pusher tool has been provided to assist you in feeding smaller material. DO NOT use any body parts or any **steel devices** inside the infeed chute area.", and page-35 operating procedures under a warning it states "Use the pusher tool to push small materials into the chipper, not your hands or feet." This exposed employees to caught in/between hazards and their associated injuries.

Proposed Penalty: \$7,000.00

Citation 1 Item 3 Type of Violation: **Serious**

1910.132(c): Located at 28 Wagner Road, Poquoson, Virginia, the employer did not assure that the gloves being utilized with the Brush Bandit wood chipper were of a safe design. The gloves had cuffs and were of a gauntlet type. Materials being fed into the wood chipper could catch the cuff of the glove and pull the employee into the machinery. The employer did not comply with the manufacturer's operating manual which states on page 10 of the Performance First Bandit Safety Manual "Do not wear gauntlet style gloves." This exposed the employees to possible caught in/between hazards and their associated injuries.

The employer had not established a program consisting of energy control procedures (lockout / tag out), employee training and periodic inspections to ensure that employees performing maintenance would not be exposed to the unexpected energizing, startup or release of stored energy.

- c. Recognition of safety and health hazards associated with the employees specific work task, including the use of measures and work practices to prevent or control those hazards.
- d. Recognition, prevention, and control of other safety and health hazards in the logging industry.
- e. Procedures, practices and requirements of the employer's worksite and the requirements of this standard.

An employee was caught in the wood chipper where he received fatal injuries.

The 14 year old employee was caught and pulled into the wood chipper where he received fatal injuries. The employer did not comply with the manufacturer's operating manual which states on page-8, 2nd column "Keep children, bystanders and small animals clear of the work area."

The investigation revealed that the employer had an operator's manual available for use and utilized the manual to perform maintenance on the wood chipper. The investigation further revealed that the victim and the 16 year old employee had been shown how to use and operate the chipper.

Proposed Penalty: \$70,000.00

Citation 2 Item 2 Type of Violation: **Willful**

16 VAC 25-60-120: Located at 28 Wagner Road, Poquoson, Virginia, employees were utilizing the Brush Bandit Model 1890 wood chipper. A 14 year old employee was caught in the wood chipper where he received fatal injuries. The employer did not comply with the manufacturer's operating manual which states on page-8, column-2 "Never operate equipment that is in need of repair or adjustment." The employer did not assure that machinery that was not in compliance with the manufacturer's requirements was either identified as unsafe and tagged or locked the controls to render them inoperable or removed the machine from its place of use or operation.

The investigation revealed that the employer had an operator's manual available for use and utilized the manual to perform maintenance on the wood chipper. The investigation further revealed that the victim and the 16 year old employee had been shown how to use and operate the chipper.

The wood chipper was documented to be in need of repair in the following instances:

- 1) Infeed tray table extension missing.
- 2) Two of two, "Last Chance" stops missing from inside of feed hopper.
- 3) Manufacturers provided wooden pusher paddle missing.
- 4) Feed control bar hydraulic valve and linkage inoperable through all ranges of motion.
- 5) Brake light wiring harness severed above intake chute, rendering brake lights inoperable.
- 6) Lower feed inspection door not installed.



- 8) Feed control bar to hydraulic control valve bar bent.
- 9) Hydraulic reservoir approximately 1/2 full vs. 7/8 full.
- 10) Left and right side Feed control bar lower mounts broken at attachment points.
- 11) Hood cover locking pin to chain attachment cable broken.
- 12) Padlock not installed on hood cover locking pin.
- 13) Feed hopper, bottom center, structural steel frame broken and bent.
- 14) Left side marker light missing.
- 15) Engine cover, left side missing.
- 16) Air breather cover/housing, duct taped to engine housing.
- 17) Winch motor retained in place with heavy gauge wire.
- 18) Brush chipper operating and parts manual was not available onsite.

Pursuant to Virginia Code § 40.1-49.4.A.4(a), the Commissioner of the Department of Labor and Industry has the authority to assess interest on all past-due penalties as well as administrative costs incurred in the collection of the penalties for violations of the Virginia Occupational Safety and Health Laws, regulations, and standards. Interest charges, as assessed at an annual rate in accordance with Virginia Code § 2.1-732, shall accrue from the date on which the citation, either as issued or as amended, becomes a final order of the Commissioner. A citation becomes a final order 15 working days after the date that the employer receives the citation unless the employer files a notice of contest with the VOSH Regional Director. Interest is waived if the employer pays the full amount within 30 calendar days of the final order date.

A debt is past-due 30 calendar days after the final order date unless the employer has made a satisfactory payment arrangement with the Commissioner. If the debt remains unpaid for more than 90 days, it will be deemed delinquent and referred to the Office of the Attorney General or another collection agency for collection. All administrative costs incurred in collecting the debt will be added to the amount of the debt.

To avoid potential interest and collection costs, please remit payment promptly for the total amount of the uncontested penalties shown on the citation to the Accounting Office, Virginia Department of Labor and Industry, Powers-Taylor Building, 13 South Thirteenth Street, Richmond, Virginia 23219.
